



# Coming in June 2007 *Science and Technology*

The Greater Cincinnati Television Educational Foundation is pleased to continue the CET Academy, an annual series that will address instructional needs of preK-12 educators, with the CET Science and Technology Academy June 18-22, 2007.



Earth and Life Sciences, along with video technology, will be the focus. CET will partner with Cincinnati Museum Center and science organizations to present an interdisciplinary and standards-based workshop experience. The Academy will include sessions on how to integrate fine arts into science and technology instruction and how to develop science and technology activities for preschoolers.

Teams may be made up of two to five educators, and the teachers must be able to form a cohesive team and support each other through communication and planning. The ideal teams will be from the same building, but multi-building teams will be accepted. Cost will be \$150 per person; each team will receive a \$500 grant to implement a science and/or technology project, field trip or speaker in the '07-'08 school year.

## **SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY ACADEMY TIMELINE:**

- ★ Application must be faxed or postmarked by **May 1, 2007**.
- ★ Participation will be confirmed by **May 15, 2007**.
- ★ Participation fee is due by **May 31, 2007**.
- ★ The Academy will be held **June 18-22, 2007**.
- ★ Teams will receive their grants by **September 2007**.

## **CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION IN CET SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY ACADEMY:**

1. The school or district's willingness to commit participants to attend the entire week of the Academy June 18-22 (9am-4pm daily at CET, with a field trip one day to the Geier Center, which is Cincinnati Museum Center's research center) and to allow the team to develop and deliver related science and technology activities at their school during the 2007-08 school year.
2. The ability to create a team of no fewer than two and no more than five members from your school or district. It is strongly recommended that a science teacher and a teacher with technology expertise be included as team members if possible. Teachers of any discipline who wish to integrate science concepts may be included. Other potential team members could be media specialists or parents who are active in your school. The participation fee is \$150 per team member, for a minimum of \$300 and a maximum of \$750. Each team will receive a \$500 grant to support science activities. *Ohio low wealth schools, please contact Krystal Cleaver for scholarship information.*

We welcome and encourage you to include your principal, technology coordinator, or other school administrator as an "ad hoc" member of the team, at no extra charge. Ad hoc members are generally not able to attend for all five days, but will be invited to join the team for a special session during the CET Academy. Their involvement is voluntary, but their support can be invaluable!

3. During the Academy, each team must develop a plan for the learning activities to be partially funded by the grant as well as an outline of a multimedia project to be completed by the group during the school year. The school or district must be willing to commit staff time to shared planning of activities and projects. Each team will take the lead in further developing its own plan and events; however, CET's staff of educators will be available for school visits and consultation as necessary for support.
4. The ability to pay the participation fee by May 31, 2007, for a team of two to five members. A principal or other school administrator may participate as an ad hoc member at no charge.
